2011 Boys Arsenal (11v11)

After a successful Spring season which culminated in EDP IV League and FC Delco Players Cup championships as well as an appearance in the EPYSA Challenge Cup finals, Arsenal starts the 2024-25 season at the Spirit United Kickoff Classic where they finished second last year. Following promotion from the EDP IV league and a greater implementation of the club's philopsophy and intended style of play in the Spring, the team will be tasked with navigating stronger competition in EDP III with the target of promotion to the USYS National League.



2011 Boys Sounders (11v11)

In their first year together as a team, Sounders hit the ground running and had an exceptional year of development. Many players who were new to the club adapted quickly to our training and standards and saw great strides throughout the year. Sounders kicks off their season at the Gettysburg Battlefield Blast where the team will look to go back-to-back after winning the championship last year.
